# HUNGARY

- Population: about 10 million.
  - 4 university clinical centers
  - No multidisciplinary transgender health center



# KISKUNHALAS

- Kiskunhalas is 50 kilometers away from University Of Szeged
- Our Hospital is a Teaching Hospital for University Of Szeged
- Hormonal treatment is partially or fully financed by insurance for those who had legal name change.
- Some surgeries was partially or fully financed by insurance for those who had legal recognition.
- Now legal recognition is not possible which means mainly private health options.

# PAST LEGAL ISSUES

- Hungary never had proper and detailed legal background for transgender people.
- It was not determined who can request gender affirmation and modification of documents, what letters from different specialists are needed or who is responsible to check or supervise the validity.

# PAST LEGAL ISSUES

- Although they had the chance to change their names and gender in their official documents since 2000, but it could be modified only until autumn in 2016.
- In 2016 ombudsman declared that legal recognition must be based on the person's identity and not the biological gender. It was stated that legal recognition is a legal issue and not a medical one.

# PAST LEGAL ISSUES

- Hungary was requested to produce correct piece of law, but this has not been created yet.
- Until 2018 nobody could change their documents.
- From January 2018 to May 2018 they used the old law and facilitated modifications for some transgender people. And then they pause judgment.

# LEGAL RECOGNITION TODAY

- 29th May 2020: a bill was rushed through and they introduced “natal gender” instead of “gender” in official documents, and this data can not be modified according to current law.

# June 2021

- “Promoting homosexuality and gender change surgery to minors” is forbidden in Hungary. Advertisements that presents homosexuality and “gender change” (affirmative) operations are also to be banned for minors.

# MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH

- Teams for adults patients only!
- MENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST TEAM
- ENDOCRINOLOGY TEAM
- GYNECOLOGY TEAM
- GENDER SURGEONS TEAM (including plastic surgeon, microvascular surgeon, laparoscopic surgeon, urologist, gynecologist)

# HORMONAL TREATMENT

- We follow 173 patients under hormonal therapy in our institution
- 102 transfeminine clients
- 71 transmasculine clients

# PRE-ASSESSMENT

- General physical examination
- Urology/gynecology exam
- Broad laboratory testing including sex hormone panels, TSH, T3, T4, bone health markers, thrombosis genetics, thrombophilia panel, viral serology of hepatitis and HIV, +/- karyotype test
- DEXA
- Ultrasound (thyroid, abdomen, breast)
- Questionnaires (demography, quality of life, sexual life, discrimination, future perspectives etc)

# GENDER AFFIRMATION SURGERY

## Masculinization

- Breast removal
- Hysterectomy and adnexectomy
- Vaginectomy
- Metoidioplasty
- Urethral reconstruction
- Scrotoplasty
- Testicle prosthesis implantation

## Feminization

- Breast augmentation
- Total penectomy
- Bilateral orchidectomy
- Penile inversion  
vaginoplasty (optional:  
rectosigmoid colon or  
peritoneal vaginoplasty)
- Urethroplasty
- Clitoroplasty
- Labioplasty

- Multidisciplinary approach of experienced team is a key of success
